# Increasing the Infringement Fee for Using a Mobile Phone While Driving

## Portfolio Transport

On 24 March 2021, the Cabinet Economic Development Committee:

- noted that the current infringement fee for using a mobile phone while driving is \$80, which was set in 2009 at the time the offence was created;
- 2 **noted** that:
  - the current fee is an anomaly in the current penalties system, and that no other individual infringement fees are set at \$80;
  - 2.2 the fee for most moving vehicle offences is \$150;
- agreed to increase the infringement fee for using a mobile phone while driving to \$150 to align with other related penalties;
- 4 **noted** that driving while using a mobile phone carries 20 demerit points, which is the same number of points that applies to several other moving vehicle offences that carry a \$150 infringement fee;
- **noted** that no changes are proposed at this time to the number of demerit points associated with using a mobile phone while driving;
- **noted** that a wider review of key road safety penalties is expected to commence later in 2021;
- 7 **noted** that to give effect to paragraph 3 above, an amendment to Schedule 1 of the Land Transport (Offences and Penalties) Regulations 1999 is required;
- **agreed** to amend Schedule 1 of the Land Transport (Offences and Penalties) Regulations 1999 to give effect to paragraph 3 above;
- 9 **noted** that the Land Transport (Offences and Penalties) Amendment Regulations 2021 will give effect to paragraph 3 above;
