Increasing the Infringement Fee for Using a Mobile Phone While Driving

Description: On 29 March 2020, Cabinet agreed to the Land Transport (Offences and Penalties) Amendment Regulations 2021, which increase the infringement fee for using a mobile phone while driving from \$80 to \$150.

These Amendment Regulations come into force on 30 April 2021.
